

## National Child Traumatic Stress Initiative – Cat II and Cat III Program Specific Guidance for indicators WD2, T3 & S1

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You are required to collect eight IPP indicators: WD2, F2, PC2, A4, T1, T3, TR1, and S1. For three of the indicators (WD2, T3, & S1) we have created sub-groups within each indicator. For these indicators you will enter the specific result names provided below.

### **Workforce Development – Indicator WD2**

WD2. The number of people in the mental health and related workforce trained in mental health-related practices/activities that are consistent with the goals of the grant.

For the workforce development trainings, do not double count people in sub categories. Some of the trainings may have people from multiple categories; make sure to put a person in only one category per training completed. If people are attending multiple sessions within a quarter to complete a training, count them only once in the quarter for that particular training. If the sessions span over two quarters count them only in the quarter the training was actually completed. In your result description please include information on the type of training that was completed and try not to use acronyms. The indicator is categorized as follows:

Result Name: WD2a Mental Health Agency

For this subgroup include mental health agency personnel such as counselors, therapists, clinicians and administrators.

Result Name: WD2b Child Welfare/Foster Care Agency

For this subgroup include child welfare and/or foster care agency personnel such as social workers, case managers, and administrators. Only include foster parents, birth parent(s) and youth if they are being considered as a part of the mental health-related workforce.

Result Name: WD2c Juvenile Justice Agency

For this subgroup include juvenile justice agency personnel such as probation officers, providers and administrators.

Result Name: WD2d School

For this subgroup include school and other educational setting personnel such as teachers, counselors, social worker, psychologists and administrators.

Result Name: WD2e Substance Abuse Agency

For this subgroup include substance abuse agency personnel such as counselors, therapists, clinicians and administrators.

Result Name: WD2f Community-Based Organization

For this subgroup include community-based organization personnel such as advocates, case managers, providers and administrators.

Result Name: WD2g First-Responder Organization

For this subgroup include first-responder organization personnel such as EMTs, providers and administrators.

Result Name: WD2h Health Care/Primary Care Organization

For this group include health care and/or primary care organization personnel such as nurses, physicians, medical assistants, and administrators.

Result Name: WD2i General Public/Other

For this group include other individuals who have been trained as a member of the mental health and related workforce that cannot be categorized in any of other categories. Be sure to describe how and in what capacity they are considered as a part of the mental health and related workforce.

## **Types and Targets of Practices – Indicator T3**

T3. The number of people receiving evidence-based mental health-related services as a result of the grant.

For the children receiving evidence-based services make sure not to double count. Include a child only in one category and they only should be counted in the quarter they begin to receive services. The indicator is categorized as follows:

Result Name: T3a Children in Child Welfare

For this subgroup include the children receiving evidence-based services that are considered part of the child welfare system.

Result Name: T3b Children in Juvenile Justice

For this subgroup include the children receiving evidence-based services that are considered part of the juvenile justice system.

Result Name: T3c Other Children

For this subgroup include the children receiving evidence-based services, but cannot be categorized in the other two categories.

## **Screening – S1**

S1. The number of individuals screened for mental health or related interventions

For the children screened by your grant make sure not to double count. Include a child only in one category. The indicator is categorized as follows:

Result Name: S1a Children in Child Welfare

For this subgroup include the children screened that are considered part of the child welfare system.

Result Name: S1b Children in Juvenile Justice

For this subgroup include the children screened that are considered part of the juvenile justice system.

Result Name: S1c Other Children

For this subgroup include the children screened, but cannot be categorized in the other two categories.
